

RESOLUTION NO. 1664

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PRESCOTT VALLEY, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF ARIZONA, REVISING THE SCHEDULE OF FEES FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT (FORMERLY THE "ENGINEERING FEES"); PROVIDING THAT IF ANY PROVISION IN THIS RESOLUTION IS HELD INVALID BY A COURT OF COMPETENT JURISDICTION, THE REMAINING PROVISIONS SHALL NOT BE AFFECTED BUT SHALL CONTINUE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BE EFFECTIVE AFTER ITS PASSAGE AND APPROVAL ACCORDING TO LAW.

WHEREAS, Arizona towns are required to appoint a town engineer who has charge of town streets, sewers and waterworks [ARS §9-462.01(A)(1) and (3)]; and

WHEREAS, such towns and other municipalities are authorized to regulate the use of buildings, structures, and land, and to regulate the location, height, bulk, number of stories, and size of buildings and structures [ARS §9-462.01(A)(1) and (3)]; and

WHEREAS, implied in such authority is authority to establish standards for construction and development of public improvements, to require engineering review and inspections, to provide maintenance of improvements, and to charge fees to cover the reasonable costs thereof not otherwise funded through general taxes; and

WHEREAS, Town Code §3-02-040 establishes the Offices of Town Engineer and Public Works Director, and provides for assignment of duties by the Town Council or the Town Manager (respectively); and

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 263 (dated July 25, 1991), the Council adopted Chapter 16 "Engineering" in the Town Code which established engineering standards for the Town and provided for adoption of fees from time to time by Council resolution; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Town Code §16-01-030, the Council adopted Resolution No. 402 (dated July 25, 1991) which initially set an Engineering Fee Schedule; and

WHEREAS, on May 25, 1995, the Council adopted Resolution No. 630 in conjunction with the FY 1995-1996 budget process to revise the Engineering Fee Schedule by adding new fees for providing GIS maps and information to the public; and

WHEREAS, on August 30, 2001, the Council adopted Resolution No. 1036 revising the Engineering Fee Schedule to simplify and adjust certain fees; and

WHEREAS, on July 11, 2002, the Council adopted Resolution No. 1093 revising the Engineering Fee Schedule by further simplifying fees and providing for sale of reports, maps and digital data to the public; and

WHEREAS, on December 1, 2005, the Council adopted Resolution No. 1398 revising the Engineering Fee Schedule to reflect actual YAG Standards publication cost in the fees; and

WHEREAS, on September 13, 2007, the Council adopted Resolution No. 1529 revising the Engineering Fee Schedule under Sections C and D related to GIS services by separating the fees under their own section labeled "GIS", defining the description of services for better clarification, and adjusting the fees to provide better cost recovery; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires now to clarify that this fee schedule applies broadly to all aspects of the Public Works Department and to add a fee that begins to cover the costs of the Town's semi-annual "clean up days";

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PRESCOTT VALLEY, ARIZONA:

1. That the Fee Schedule for Public Works activities, most recently established in Resolution No. 1529 (dated September 13, 2007), is hereby amended to read as follows:


